




If there was a splash pad, how often would you or your family members use it?













How often would you use the pumptrack if one was located at Phelan Community Park?


















FLOOR PLAN





B. View Looking Southeast








Preliminary Shade Layout























Phelan Park Aesthetic Survey


Prop 68 Grant Funding

- Last round of the statewide Prop 68 grants (around 400 million dedicated to parks throughout California)
- Park qualifies for this grant given the lack of parkland in the area
- Considering this is an expansion of parkland, we don't get the full points for a new park
- Major selection criteria includes
 - Project Location
 - Community Engagement
 - Operation and Maintenance Considerations
 - Summary About Project Needs, Benefits, & Readiness
