

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-14
A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE PHELAN PINON HILLS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
ADOPTING THE 2025 MOJAVE REGIONAL URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN
AS IT APPLIES TO THE PHELAN PIÑON HILLS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT,
INCLUDING THE DISTRICT'S WATER SHORTAGE CONTINGENCY PLAN

WHEREAS, the Phelan Pinon Hills Community Services District ("District") is an urban water supplier that provides water service within its service area; and

WHEREAS, the California Urban Water Management Planning Act, Water Codes sections 10610 et seq., requires urban water suppliers to prepare and adopt an Urban Water Management Plan at least once every 5 years; and

WHEREAS, Water Code section 10632 requires each urban water supplier to prepare and adopt a Water Shortage Contingency Plan as part of its Urban Water Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, Water Code section 10642 requires that, prior to adoption, the Urban Water Management Plan and Water Shortage Contingency Plan be made available for public inspection and that the urban water supplier hold a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, for the 2025 planning cycle, Mojave Water Agency coordinated the preparation of the 2025 Mojave Regional Urban Water Management Plan, which includes regional chapters and individual retailer-specific chapters for participating urban water suppliers, including the District; and

WHEREAS, the 2025 Mojave Regional Urban Water Management Plan includes the applicable regional chapters, the District-specific chapter, the District's Water Shortage Contingency Plan, and applicable appendices; and

WHEREAS, the District participated in the development of the 2025 Mojave Regional Urban Water Management Plan by providing District-specific data and information for inclusion in the plan; and

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing was published in accordance with applicable noticing requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors held a duly noticed public hearing on June 10, 2026, at which time the Board received and considered public comment regarding the 2025 Mojave Regional Urban Water Management Plan as it applies to the District's service area, including the District's Water Shortage Contingency Plan; and

WHEREAS, after considering the 2025 Mojave Regional Urban Water Management Plan, the District's Water Shortage Contingency Plan, applicable appendices, staff's recommendation, and any public comment received, the Board desires to approve and adopt the plan as it applies to the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Phelan Piñon Hills Community Services District as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The Board of Directors hereby approves and adopts the 2025 Mojave Regional Urban Water Management Plan as it applies to the Phelan Piñon Hills Community Services District, including the applicable regional chapters, the District-specific chapter, the District's Water Shortage Contingency Plan, and all applicable appendices.

Section 3. The General Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to submit the adopted 2025 Mojave Regional Urban Water Management Plan, as it applies to the District, including the District's Water Shortage Contingency Plan and applicable appendices, to the California Department of Water Resources.

Section 4. The General Manager, or designee, is further authorized to take any actions necessary or appropriate to carry out the intent of this Resolution, including providing any additional documentation, certifications, or information required for submittal, filing, or implementation of the adopted plan.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

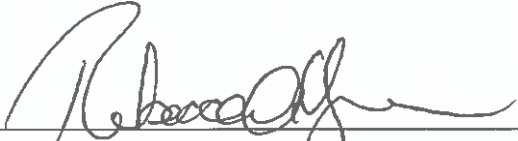
